Public schools-youth nutrition education programs.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to public schools; imposing requirements
2 upon school districts; appropriating funds to the
3 University of Wyoming cooperative extension service for
4 youth nutrition education programs; authorizing a position;
5 and providing for effective dates.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-3-110(a) by creating a new
10 paragraph (xxx) is amended to read:

11

12 **21-3-110. Duties of boards of trustees.**

13

14 (a) The board of trustees in each school district
15 shall:

16

1 (xxx) Establish and implement a district
2 wellness advisory council to ensure district wellness
3 policy is properly implemented in district schools and that
4 the district policy contains elements required under the
5 federal Child Nutrition and Women, Infants and Children
6 Reauthorization Act of 2004.

8 **Section 2.**

9
10 (a) To promote enjoyable and healthy lifestyles for
11 Wyoming elementary school students including healthy
12 eating, physical activity and respect for self and others,
13 the following amounts are appropriated from the general
14 fund to the University of Wyoming college of agriculture
15 cooperative extension service to fund the following youth
16 nutrition education programs:

17
18 (i) Two hundred fifty-six thousand fifty dollars
19 (\$256,050.00) for the expansion of youth nutrition
20 education programs in grades two (2) and three (3)
21 commencing with the 2006 fall semester;

23 (ii) Three hundred thousand dollars
24 (\$300,000.00) to develop and implement youth nutrition

1 education programs in grades five (5) and six (6)
2 commencing with the 2007 spring semester;

3

4 (iii) One hundred twenty thousand dollars
5 (\$120,000.00) to develop youth nutrition education programs
6 in grades kindergarten, one (1) and four (4). The
7 university is authorized an additional full-time position
8 for purposes of this paragraph.

9

10 (b) The amounts appropriated under subsection (a) of
11 this section shall be for the period beginning on the
12 effective date of this section and ending June 30, 2008.

13

14 **Section 3.**

15

16 (a) Except as provided under subsection (b) of this
17 section, this act is effective July 1, 2007.

18

1 (b) Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this section,
2 section 2 of this act is effective immediately upon
3 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
4 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
5 Constitution.
