FIFTY-NINTH LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING 2007 GENERAL SESSION

AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; creating a crime involving the use of false identity, citizenship or resident alien documents; providing a penalty; providing for seizure; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 6-3-614 is created to read:

6-3-614. Use of false identity, citizenship or resident alien documents, penalty.

- (a) Any person who intentionally uses false documents to conceal his true identity, citizenship or resident alien status to obtain access to public resources or services is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, a fine of not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), or both.
- An official who is presented with any document in connection with an application for a driver's license or identification card issued by the department of transportation, and who has probable cause to believe that it is a false document in violation of subsection (a) of this section, is authorized to seize and retain the document. Upon seizure, the document shall be delivered to a law enforcement official having jurisdiction investigate the violation soon as as reasonably possible. If the investigation shows that the document is not a false document, the document shall be returned to the person immediately.
