A BILL

for

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing to amend the Wyoming

2 Constitution to modify the signature requirement for a

3 petition for an initiative or referendum; changing the

4 requirement from fifteen percent of those resident in at

5 least two-thirds of the counties to at least fifteen

6 percent of those resident in at least two-thirds of the

7 senate districts in the state.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,

10 two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting

11 separately, concurring therein:

13 **Section 1.** The following proposal to amend Wyoming

14 Constitution, Article 3, Section 52(c)(ii) is proposed for

15 submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the

- 1 next general election for approval or rejection to become
- 2 valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a
- 3 majority of the electors at the election:

5 Article 3, Section 52. Initiative and referendum.

- 7 (c) After certification of the application, a
- 8 petition containing a summary of the subject matter shall
- 9 be prepared by the secretary of state for circulation by
- 10 the sponsors. The petition may be filed with the secretary
- 11 of state if it meets both of the following requirements:

- 13 (ii) It is signed by qualified voters equal in
- 14 number to fifteen percent (15%) of those resident in at
- 15 least two-thirds (2/3) of the counties—senate districts of
- 16 the state, as determined by those who voted in the
- 17 preceding general election in that county each senate
- 18 district.

- 20 **Section 2.** That the Secretary of State shall endorse
- 21 the following statement on the proposed amendment:

1 The passage of this amendment would change the requirement

2 for petition signatures for an initiative or referendum.

3 Currently a petition must be signed by at least fifteen

4 percent (15%) of the qualified voters in at least two-

5 thirds (2/3) of the counties, as determined by those who

6 voted in the last general election. This amendment would

7 change the requirement to at least fifteen percent (15%) of

8 the qualified voters in at least two-thirds (2/3) of the

9 senate districts, as determined by those who voted in the

10 last general election.
