A BILL

for

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing to amend the Wyoming
 2 Constitution; providing for the legislature to enact laws
 3 to establish a system of voting by mailed ballots as
 4 specified.

6 *BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,*
 7 *two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting*
 8 *separately, concurring therein:*

10 **Section 1.** The following proposal to amend Wyoming
 11 Constitution, Article 6, Section 22 is proposed for
 12 submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the
 13 next general election for approval or rejection to become
 14 valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a
 15 majority of the electors at the election:

16

1 **Article 6, Section 22. Absent and mailed voter**
2 **ballots, voting and registration.**

3
4 The provisions of section 11 of article 6 of this
5 constitution, which provides that the ballots therein
6 mentioned shall be delivered on election day to the voters
7 within the polling place by sworn public officials, and
8 that only such ballots so delivered shall be received and
9 counted, shall not be applicable to, affect or invalidate
10 absent or mailed voter ballots and voting thereof and
11 registration therefor, as provided by ~~article 14, of~~
12 ~~chapter 36, Wyoming Revised Statutes, 1931,~~ article 9, of
13 title 22, Wyoming Revised Statutes, 2006 and other acts of
14 the legislature of the State of Wyoming, amendatory thereof
15 or related thereto, whether heretofore or hereafter
16 enacted.

18 **Section 2.** That the Secretary of State shall endorse
19 the following statement on the proposed amendment:

20

1 This amendment would allow the Wyoming legislature to enact
2 laws providing for a system of voting by mailed ballots in
3 all elections.
