A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to post-secondary education; requiring the
2 University of Wyoming and Wyoming community colleges to
3 fully honor institutional scholarships to students without
4 reduction for funds received for Hathaway scholarships as
5 specified; and providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** 2006 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 36,
10 Section 3(a)(ii) is amended to read:

14 (a) The legislature recognizes that eligible
15 institutions will have made substantial
16 scholarship commitments to students who plan to
17 enroll for the fall of 2006 school year by the

1 time this act is enacted into law. Notwithstanding
2 any other provision of this act:

4 (ii) In subsequent years for students
5 receiving Hathaway scholarships for the 2006-2007
6 school year to whom eligible institutions made
7 institutional scholarship commitments beyond the
8 2006-2007 school year, the Hathaway scholarships
9 provided under this act shall not be reduced as
10 provided in paragraph (i) of this subsection, ~~but~~
11 ~~and~~ the institution ~~may~~ shall not reduce its
12 annual institutional scholarship commitment to the
13 student ~~by an amount not to exceed the~~ based in
14 any manner upon Hathaway merit or need scholarship
15 funds provided to the student. ~~, excluding need~~
16 ~~based scholarships provided under W.S. 21-16-1306,~~
17 ~~so that the Hathaway scholarship supplants and is~~
18 ~~not an addition to the institutional scholarship.~~
19 ~~To the extent that the institution reduces its~~
20 ~~scholarship commitments under this paragraph, the~~
21 ~~institution shall specify the purposes for which~~
22 ~~those commitments were reallocated in its report~~
23 ~~required under section 4 of this act.~~
