AN ACT relating to state symbols; designating western wheatgrass as the state grass of Wyoming; and providing for an effective date.

*Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

**Section 1.** W.S. 8-3-121 is created to read:

**8-3-121. State grass.**

The *Agropyron smithii* (*Pascopyrum smithii*), commonly known as western wheatgrass, is the state grass of Wyoming.
