A BILL

- 1 AN ACT relating to trade and commerce; providing for a
- 2 study by the attorney general of pricing of motor vehicle
- 3 fuels; providing for assistance by other state agencies;
- 4 providing for a report; and providing for an effective
- 5 date.

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7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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9 Section 1.

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- 11 (a) The attorney general shall study the pricing of
- 12 gasoline and other motor vehicle fuels within the state of
- 13 Wyoming at both the wholesale and retail levels. The study
- 14 shall include:

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- 16 (i) An analysis of current pricing of those
- 17 fuels and historical pricing within the past five (5)

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- 1 years, statewide and by regions within Wyoming, to include
- 2 five (5) geographic regions, being the northeast,
- 3 northwest, southeast, southwest and central with the exact
- 4 division established by the attorney general as he
- 5 determines best for purposes of the study;

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- 7 (ii) A comparison for the same period of overall
- 8 motor vehicle fuel prices at the retail and wholesale
- 9 levels in Wyoming, with each state bordering Wyoming, and
- 10 with the entire United States;

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- 12 (iii) An analysis of how wholesale and retail
- 13 motor vehicle fuel prices are set in Wyoming and whether
- 14 the results of the study give any indication of unlawful,
- 15 unjust, collusive or predatory price manipulation in
- 16 Wyoming; and

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- 18 (iv) An analysis of current Wyoming law
- 19 providing for restrictions or prohibitions on unlawful,
- 20 unjust, collusive or predatory manipulation of motor
- 21 vehicle fuel prices.

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- 23 (b) All state agencies, including the University of
- 24 Wyoming, shall cooperate with and assist the attorney

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1 general as requested in performing the duties required

2 under this act.

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4 (c) The attorney general shall report the results of 5 the study to the joint judiciary interim committee by November 1, 2007. The report shall 6 include 7 recommendations for statutory changes to prohibit or restrict unjust, collusive or predatory manipulation of 8 9 motor vehicle fuel prices and to authorize investigations 10 and actions by the attorney general or other

enforcement officials to enforce those prohibitions or

12 restrictions.

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(d) The joint judiciary interim committee shall review the report and may sponsor legislation to implement any recommendations or other legislation it deems beneficial to ensure that Wyoming citizens are assured fair pricing of motor vehicle fuels in the state.

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Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon 1 2

completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 3

4 Constitution.
