- 1 AN ACT relating to community colleges; establishing a task
- 2 force to review, evaluate and develop recommendations on

- 4 imposing reporting requirements; providing appropriations;

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

9 Section 1.

- 11 (a) There is created a community college planning
- 12 task force to consist of the following:

- 14 (i) The chairman of the senate education
- 15 committee;

1	(ii) The chairman of the house education

4	(iii) Nine (9) members appointed by the governor								
5	as follows:

7	(A) Two (2) representatives of community								
8	colleges to reflect academic and vocational missions of the								
9	colleges;

11	(B) One (1) member representing the								
12	department of workforce services;

14	(C) One (1) member representing the Wyoming								
15	travel, recreation and tourism industry;								
16									
17	(D) One (1) representative of the Wyoming								
18	oil and gas industry;								
19									
20	(E) One (1) representative of the Wyoming								
21	mining industry;

23	(F) One (1) representative of the small								
24	business community in Wyoming;

2 (G) One (1) representative of the Wyoming 3 health care industry;

5 (H) One (1) representative of the public.

(b) The task force shall comprehensively review and 7 evaluate the existing community college system and develop 8 9 recommendations on the most efficient and effective manner 10 in which to provide community college educational and 11 workforce preparation programs and services in Wyoming, including community college structure, governance, 12 13 revenues, programs, including programs addressing opportunities for post-secondary education re-entry, and 14 15 the integration of post-secondary programs with public school programs. 16

(c) Appointments shall be in sufficient time to 18 enable the first meeting of the task force to be held not 19 20 later than May 1, 2007. At this initial meeting, the task 21 force shall select a chair and vice-chair from among its 22 membership. Thereafter, task force meetings shall be 23 scheduled upon the call of the chair.

1	(d)	The	task	force	may	retain	consultants	as

3 governor's office shall staff the task force and state

4 agencies shall provide information to the task force as

5 requested in order to fulfill its duties.

7 (e) Legislative members of the task force shall

8 receive compensation, per diem and travel expenses in the

9 manner and amount as prescribed by W.S. 28-5-101.

10 Remaining task force members who are not state employees

11 shall receive the per diem and mileage paid members of the

12 Wyoming legislature under W.S. 28-5-101 for each day of

13 actual task force meetings and travel to those meetings.

15 (f) The task force shall report its findings and

16 recommendations to the governor, the joint appropriations

17 interim committee and the joint education interim committee

18 by June 1, 2008. The joint education interim committee

19 shall forward any legislation necessary to implement task

20 force recommendations to the 2009 legislature.

22 (g) This section is repealed March 31, 2009.

2 (a) One hundred twenty-five thousand dollars

3 (\$125,000.00) is appropriated from the general fund to the

4 governor for the period commencing on the effective date of

5 this act and ending March 31, 2009, as necessary to fund

6 the community college planning task force in carrying out

7 its duties under this act.

9 (b) For the period beginning on the effective date of

10 this act and ending March 31, 2009, ten thousand dollars

11 (\$10,000.00) is appropriated from the general fund to the

12 legislative service office to fund the expenses of the

13 state legislative members of the task force to complete the

14 duties assigned to the task force.

16 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon

17 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

18 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

19 Constitution.
