4 (e) The department shall actively monitor big game 5 animal herd populations statewide to determine whether and to what extent the gray wolf is negatively impacting big 6 7 game animal herds, and thereby hunting opportunities. the extent permitted by this title, and notwithstanding 8 9 other provisions of this title by those means authorized by the commission, the department shall manage the gray wolf 10 11 population, as necessary to ensure the long-term health and viability of any big game animal herd that is being 12 13 threatened in this state.

(c) In order to accomplish the purposes of this act, the game and fish commission shall enter into a memorandum of understanding with appropriate federal agencies under which the commission and federal agencies shall endeavor to manage the prey base for gray wolves in a manner to maintain a sufficient prey base in Yellowstone National Park, Grand Teton National Park and John D. Rockefeller, Jr. Memorial Parkway within the

1 state for at least eight (8) packs breeding pairs 2 of wolves. The game and fish commission shall 3 endeavor to manage big game populations providing a prey base for seven (7) packs breeding pairs of 4 5 gray wolves in all other areas of the state in such a manner as to mitigate to the greatest 6 7 extent possible, adverse effects on opportunities for licensed hunters to take big game. 8

10 **Section 3.** W.S. 23-1-304(b) is repealed.

Section 4. There is appropriated from the general fund to the game and fish commission for the fiscal biennium ending June 30, 2008, two million four hundred thousand dollars (\$2,400,000.00) for purposes of managing gray wolves.

Section 5. There are approved eight (8) full-time positions and three (3) full-time at-will-employee contract (AWEC) positions for the game and fish commission as a part of the appropriation from the general fund. The commission shall develop, with the department of administration and information, an expense organization which appropriates any future funding for purposes of managing grey wolves.
