#### 99-3-1201. Definitions.

The definitions in W.S. 99-3-101 apply to this article.

#### 99-3-1202. General authorization.

The provisions of W.S. 99-3-102 apply to this article.

# 99-3-1003. Level III construction projects - new development.

- (a) Authorization is granted for the Level III new development construction projects identified in this section subject to the general conditions specified in W.S. 99-3-103.
  - (b) Project Casper Zone III:

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- (i) Project sponsor: City of Casper;
- (ii) Project purpose: Municipal supply;
- (iii) Project description: Design and construction of transmission pipelines, a booster pump station and appurtenances necessary to make the project function in the manner intended;
- (iv) Total project budget: Three million two
  hundred thousand dollars (\$3,200,000.00);
