## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to administration of government;
- 2 redistributing certain federal mineral lease bonus payments
- 3 to the state highway fund for a specified period; repealing
- 4 related obsolete provisions; and providing for an effective

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- 9 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-4-601(b)(i)(intro), (iv)(A), (B)
- 10 and (v) is amended to read:

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- 12 9-4-601. Distribution and use; funds, accounts,
- 13 cities and towns benefited; exception for bonus payments.

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- 15 (b) The state treasurer shall ascertain and withhold
- 16 all bonus payments received from the federal government
- 17 attributable to coal, oil shale or geothermal leases of

federal land within Wyoming and shall distribute it as 1 2 follows: 3 4 Fifty percent (50%), the first seven million (i) 5 five hundred thousand dollars (\$7,500,000.00) of which shall be distributed as follows, but for the fiscal years 6 7 beginning July 1, 2004 and July 1, 2005 any amount in excess of seven million five hundred thousand dollars 8 9 (\$7,500,000.00) shall be deposited in accordance with 10 paragraph (v) of this subsection, and thereafter any amount 11 in excess of seven million five hundred thousand dollars 12 (\$7,500,000.00) per year shall be deposited into the school 13 capital construction account established under W.S. 14 21-15-111(a)(i): 15 16 (iv) And: 17 (A) Ten percent (10%) but not to exceed one 18 million six hundred thousand dollars (\$1,600,000.00) per 19 20 year, to a separate account which may be expended by the 21 community college commission in accordance with and in 22 addition to appropriations available under W.S. 23 21-18-205(c). For the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2004 24 and July 1, 2005, any amount in excess of one million six

    The amounts specified shall be deposited to the business
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1 ready community account highway fund in the fiscal year 2 specified but only if as of July 1 of the specified fiscal 3 year, using the most recent consensus revenue estimating 4 group estimates, there is projected to be a positive 5 balance in the school capital construction account as of June 30 of that fiscal year, after all appropriations from 6 7 account for the purposes specified in 21-15-111(a)(i), for that fiscal year are deducted. Amounts 8 9 deposited to the business ready community account highway 10 fund pursuant to this paragraph shall be deposited as 11 provided by W.S. 9-4-602. These deposits shall be reduced as necessary to maintain a projected positive balance in 12 13 school capital construction account after all the 14 appropriations from that account for the purposes specified in W.S. 21-15-111(a)(i), for the applicable fiscal year, 15 are deducted.
