- 13 or during a closed season prohibited.

- 15 (a) Any person who takes any elk or moose without the
- 16 proper license is guilty of a 4th third degree misdemeanor.

1 (b) Any person who takes any bighorn sheep, mountain 2 goat, mountain lion, grizzly bear or, gray wolf where classified as a trophy game animal, without the proper 3 4 license except as otherwise permitted by this act is guilty 5 of a 4th second degree misdemeanor. 6 23-3-403. False swearing, fraud or false statement 7 8 prohibited. 9 10 (b) Violation of this section constitutes a fifth 11 second degree misdemeanor. 12 23-6-202. Fines and sentences. 13 14 (a) Any person who has been convicted of or pleaded 15 guilty to any offense under this act may be fined, 16 17 sentenced to the county jail, or both, as follows: 18 19 (i) Up to two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) ten 20 thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) to which may be added 21 imprisonment up to one (1) year when the offense is a 1st 22 degree misdemeanor; 23
