1	AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; providing an
2	increased penalty for aggravated assault against a pregnant
3	woman which results in termination of the pregnancy;
4	providing such an act is an aggravating circumstance for
5	the imposition of the death penalty in homicide cases as
6	specified; and providing for an effective date.

8	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
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10	Section 1. W.S. 6-2-102(h) by creating a new
11	paragraph (xiii) and 6-2-502(b) are amended to read:
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13	6-2-102. Presentence hearing for murder in the first
14	degree; mitigating and aggravating circumstances; effect of
15	error in hearing.
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1	(h) Aggravating circumstances are limited to the
2	following:
3	
4	(xiii) The defendant killed a pregnant woman
5	resulting in a termination of the pregnancy without a live
6	birth and the defendant was the biological father of the
7	unborn embryo or fetus.

9	6-2-502. Aggravated assault and battery; penalty.
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11	(b) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection,
12	aggravated assault and battery is a felony punishable by
13	imprisonment for not more than ten (10) years. Aggravated
14	assault and battery under paragraph (a)(iv) of this section
15	is a felony punishable by imprisonment for not less than
16	ten (10) years and not more than twenty (20) years, if the
17	act of the defendant resulted in the termination of the
18	pregnancy without a live birth.

20	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2007.
