- 13 (a) Any person who has previously pleaded guilty to
- 14 or been convicted of committing or attempting to commit a
- 15 violent felony or a felony under W.S. 6-5-204(b), and has
- 16 not been pardoned and who uses or knowingly possesses any

1	firearm is guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment
2	for not more than three (3) years, a fine of not more than
3	five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00), or both.

5	(b) For the purposes of this section only, "firearm"
6	does not include:

8	(i) A firearm, including a firearm with a
9	matchlock, flintlock, percussion cap or similar type of
10	ignition system, if the firearm was manufactured on or
11	before December 31, 1898;

(ii) A replica of a firearm described in paragraph (i) of this subsection if the replica: 14

16 (A) Is not designed or redesigned to use 17 rimfire or conventional centerfire fixed ammunition;

19 (B) Uses rimfire or conventional centerfire 20 fixed ammunition which is no longer manufactured in the 21 United States and which is not readily available in the ordinary channels of commercial trade; or 22

1	(iii) A muzzle loading rifle, muzzle loading
2	shotgun or muzzle loading pistol which is designed to use
3	black powder, or a black powder substitute, if it cannot
4	use fixed ammunition. Notwithstanding any provision of
5	this paragraph, any weapon which incorporates a firearm
6	frame or receiver which can be readily converted to fire
7	fixed ammunition by replacing the barrel, bolt, breechblock
8	or any combination thereof is within the meaning of
9	"firearm" as used in this section.
