for

1 AN ACT relating to probation and parole; providing that
2 specified payments may be required as conditions of parole;
3 and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 7-13-421(b) is amended to read:

8

9 **7-13-421. Restitution as condition of parole.**

10

11 (b) The board shall provide for restitution in the
12 amount determined by the court pursuant to W.S. 7-9-103
13 unless the board finds the parolee is not reasonably
14 capable of making the payments, in which case the board may
15 modify the amount of restitution to be paid, taking into
16 account the factors enumerated in W.S. 7-9-106. The board
17 may require payment of the following obligations as

1 conditions of parole if it finds the parolee is reasonably
2 capable of making the payments, taking into account the
3 factors enumerated in W.S. 7-9-106(a)(iii):

5 (i) Support of dependents of the parolee;

6

7 (ii) Court ordered fines, reimbursement for the
8 services of the public defender or court appointed counsel
9 and the surcharge imposed under W.S. 1-40-119;

10

11 (iii) Partial costs of evaluations, treatment,
12 services, programs or assistance the parolee is receiving;

13

14 (iv) Partial cost of supervision of the parolee.

15

16 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2007.
