1	(a) The claimant shall prepare the affidavit as set
2	forth., or at his request the circuit judge shall draft it
3	for him. When the affidavit is executed by the claimant the
4	court shall file the same and have summons served on the
5	defendant at any location in the county in the manner
6	provided by law or, if the defendant resides in the county,
7	service may be made by the court by certified mail
8	addressed to the defendant at his address within the county
9	with return receipt requested. Upon receipt by the circuit
10	judge of the return receipt signed by the defendant or his

The procedure of municipal courts shall conform to the procedure provided by law and rules of procedure for courts of limited jurisdiction.
