- 7-13-408. Probation, parole and conditional release
- 12 revocation hearing procedures.

1 (e) The department may establish by rule and regulation a system of imposing the administrative 2 3 sanctions specified in W.S. 7-13-1107(b) as an alternative to revocation of the parole of any parolee who has violated 4 5 a condition of his parole. Parolees committed to the county jail or a residential community correctional program 6 7 pursuant to this subsection shall be housed in accordance with W.S. 7-13-1107 (c) or 7-18-115 (b). 8

10 7-13-420. Good time allowances.

11

12 The governor, after consultation with the board (a) 13 and the department, shall adopt rules and regulations to 14 establish a system of good time and special good time 15 allowances for inmates of and parolees from any state penal institution, any institution which houses Wyoming inmates 16 17 pursuant to W.S. 7-3-401 or any correctional facility 18 operated pursuant to a contract with the state under W.S. 7-22-102 or inmates or parolees transferred to a community 19 correctional facility pursuant to W.S. 7-18-109. The rules 20 21 may provide either for good time to be deducted from the maximum sentence or for good time to be deducted from the 22 23 minimum sentence imposed by the sentencing court, or both.

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2008.
