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6	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
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8	Section 1. W.S. 35-1-1001 is created to read:

11	PHYSICIAN RECRUITMENT GRANT PROGRAM

35-1-1101. Physician recruitment grant program.

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2 (a) There is created the Wyoming physician

3 recruitment program administered by the department.

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5 (b) There is created the Wyoming physician

6 recruitment account. Funds in the account are continuously

7 appropriated to the department and shall be used to provide

8 grants to hospitals for physician recruitment as provided

9 in this section.

10

11 (c) The department shall promulgate rules and

12 regulations to administer the program. The rules and

13 regulations shall include provisions for:

14

15 (i) Application forms for grants under the

16 program;

17

18 (ii) Criteria for grants under the program.

19 Grants may be provided under the following conditions:

20

21 (A) The physician shall be recruited to the

22 geographic area served by the hospital;

1	(B) The physician shall move his medical
2	practice at least twenty-five (25) miles or the physician's
3	new medical practice shall derive at least seventy-five
4	percent (75%) of its revenues from professional services
5	furnished to patients not seen or treated at his prior
6	medical practice during the preceding three (3) years;
7	
8	(C) The recruitment conditions between the
9	hospital and the physician shall meet the conditions set
10	forth in 42 C.F.R. 411.357(e), as amended March 1, 2007;
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12	(D) Recruitment of new physicians shall be
13	based on demonstrable need. Those hospitals demonstrating
14	the greatest need, in the discretion of the department
15	shall be given the highest priority in receiving grants
16	pursuant to this section;
17	
18	(E) Recruitment incentives shall not be
19	offered for longer than two (2) years;
20	
21	(F) All recruitment incentives shall be in
22	writing and shall be reported on federal income tax forms;

1 (G) The recruited physician shall agree to

2 provide medical services in the community to which he was

3 recruited for a period of not less than four (4) years or

4 he shall repay any monies granted under this section to the

5 state of Wyoming plus interest at the rate of ten percent

6 (10%) per annum; and

8 (H) The recruited physician shall agree to

9 provide medical care for not less than four (4) years in

10 underserved areas of the state and shall accept patients

11 qualified under the Medical Assistance and Services Act,

12 Title XVIII of the federal Social Security Act and the

13 child health insurance program who seek medical care which

14 the health care provider is qualified to provide or he

15 shall repay any monies granted under this section to the

16 state of Wyoming plus interest at the rate of ten percent

17 (10%) per annum.

Powers and duties. 15 (a) The department of health, through the state 16 health officer, or under his direction and supervision, 17 through the other employees of the department, shall have 18 19 and exercise the following powers and duties: 20 21 Administer the Wyoming (xxii) physician

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recruitment grant program provided in W.S. 35-1-1101.

1 **Section 3.** There is appropriated seven hundred fifty

2 thousand dollars (\$750,000.00) from the general fund to the

3 Wyoming physician recruitment account created in section 1

4 of this act for purposes of this act.

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6 **Section 4.** This act is effective July 1, 2008.
