Election judges.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to elections; providing that election
2 judges may work shifts on election day; providing for
3 excused absences for student election judges; repealing
4 conflicting statutes; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 22-8-117 and 22-13-118 are created to
9 read:

10

11 **22-8-117. Excused absences for student election**
12 **judges.**

13

14 (a) An election judge who is a student of a public
15 school shall be excused from school on election day and

1 those days necessary for training school under W.S.
2 22-8-113.

3

4 (b) The county clerk shall provide notification no
5 later than seven (7) days before the student election
6 judges first necessary absences to each school district
7 superintendent in the county stating:

8

9 (i) The name of each student in the district
10 serving as election judges;

11

12 (ii) The school the student attends; and

13

14 (iii) The dates for which the student is excused
15 under subsection (a) of this section.

16

17 **22-13-118. Judges work schedule.**

18

19 At the discretion of the county clerk, election judges may
20 be allowed to work at the polling premise on election day
21 for a period of time less than the total amount of time the
22 polls are open provided the polling station has a
23 sufficient number of election judges on duty at all times
24 to comply with the requirements of this title. An election

1 judge shall not leave his polling station during his work
2 shift.

3

4 **Section 2.** W.S. 22-13-116 is repealed.

5

6 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon
7 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become a law
8 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
9 Constitution.
