A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to community colleges; modifying limits of  
2 capital construction projects subject to legislative and  
3 commission approval as specified; and providing for an  
4 effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-18-202(d)(iv) and 21-18-205(g) are  
9 amended to read:

10

11 **21-18-202. Powers and duties of the commission.**

12

13 (d) The commission shall perform the following  
14 approval functions:

15

16 (iv) Approve all new capital construction  
17 projects in excess of ~~fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00)~~

1 one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) for which state  
 2 funds are or could be eventually applied. "New capital  
 3 construction projects" include:

4  
 5 (A) New construction, renovation and  
 6 capital renewal in excess of ~~fifty thousand dollars~~  
 7 ~~(\$50,000.00)~~ one hundred thousand (\$100,000.00) market  
 8 value which is not necessary maintenance or repair; ~~and~~

9  
 10 (B) The acquisition of real property in  
 11 excess of ~~fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00)~~ one hundred  
 12 thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) market value whether by  
 13 purchase or exchange; ~~and~~

14  
 15 (C) Previously approved and uncompleted new  
 16 capital construction projects which have increased in total  
 17 cost by ten percent (10%) or more since cost estimates were  
 18 developed at the time of initial project approval under  
 19 this paragraph and W.S. 21-18-205(g).

 21 **21-18-205. Appropriation and distribution of state**  
 22 **funds; restrictions; budget authority.**

23

1 (g) No state funds shall be used for the maintaining,  
2 operating or equipping of any capital construction project  
3 in excess of ~~three hundred fifty thousand dollars~~  
4 ~~(\$350,000.00)~~ one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) which was  
5 not approved by the commission and authorized by the  
6 legislature.

8 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2008.
