5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 24-1-101(a) is amended to read:

- 9 24-1-101. Public highways defined and established;
- 10 creation by adverse possession.

- 12 (a) On and after January 1, 1924, all roads within
- 13 this state shall be highways, which have been or may be
- 14 declared by law to be state or county highways. It shall be
- 15 the duty of the several boards of county commissioners,
- 16 within their respective counties, prior to said date, to

1 determine what, if any, such roads now or heretofore 2 travelled but not heretofore officially established and recorded, are necessary or important for the public use as 3 permanent roads, and to cause such roads to be recorded, or 4 5 if need be laid out, established and recorded, and all roads recorded as aforesaid, shall be highways. No other 6 roads, except roads located on federal public lands prior 7 to October, 1976 which provide access for a private 8 9 residence or agricultural operation, shall be highways unless and until lawfully established as such by official 10 authority. Except, nothing contained herein 11 shall construed as preventing the creation or establishment of a 12 13 public highway right-of-way with reference to state and 14 county highways under the common-law doctrines of adverse possession or prescription either prior to or subsequent to 15 the enactment hereof. If any such board shall resolve the 16 17 creation or establishment of a public highway right-of-way based upon the common-law doctrines of adverse possession 18 or prescription, it shall, following the filing of a plat 19 20 and accurate survey required in accordance with the terms 21 provisions of W.S. 24-3-109, proceed with the 22 publication of the proposed road for three (3) successive weeks in three (3) successive issues of some official 23 24 newspaper published in the county, if any such there be,

1	and if no newspaper be published therein, such notice shall
2	be posted in at least three (3) public places along the
3	line of the proposed road, which notice shall be exclusive
4	of all other notices and may be in the following form:

6	To all whom it may concern: The board of county
7	commissioners of county has resolved the creation and
8	establishment of a public highway right-of-way under the
9	common-law doctrine of prescription in that the road was
10	constructed or substantially maintained by the (either the
11	state or county) for general public use for a period of
12	(ten years or longer) said road commencing at in
13	county, Wyoming, running thence (here describe in general
14	terms the points and courses thereof), and terminating at
15	••••

17	All objections thereto must be filed in writing with
18	the county clerk of said county before noon on the day
19	of A.D.,, or such road will be established
20	without reference to such objections.
