A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to driver services; increasing driver's
2 licenses fees and other fees as specified; and providing
3 for an effective date.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7 Section 1. W.S. 31-7-113(a)(i) through (ix), (d) and
8 (e) and 31-8-104 are amended to read:

10 31-7-113. Fees.

12 (a) The following fees are imposed:

14 (i) Driver's license.....\$20.00-\$40.00

16 (ii) Instruction permit.....\$20.00-\$40.00

(iii) Restricted license under W.S. 31-7-117(c)

(iv) Duplicate or renewal.....~~\$15.00~~ \$30.00

(vi) Commercial driver's license....~~\$25.00~~ \$45.00

(vii) Commercial driver instruction permit
.....~~\$20.00~~ \$45.00

(viii) Commercial license renewal or duplicate
.....~~\$20.00~~ \$40.00

(ix) Commercial driver's license skills test
conducted by the department.....~~\$40.00~~ \$75.00

(d) If a driver's license with limited driving
privileges is granted pursuant to W.S. 31-7-105(f), the fee
shall be ~~twenty five dollars (\$25.00)~~ forty-five dollars
(\$45.00).

1 (e) Notwithstanding W.S. 31-7-131(c), if a driver's
2 license is reinstated after a period of suspension or
3 revocation, the fee for the reinstatement shall be ~~fifty~~
4 ~~dollars (\$50.00)~~ ninety dollars (\$90.00) unless the final
5 decision by the hearing examiner, or a court reverses the
6 action taken by the department. If a driver's license is
7 reinstated after suspension for nonpayment of child support
8 pursuant to W.S. 20-6-111 or 20-6-112, the fee for
9 reinstatement shall be not more than five dollars (\$5.00).

11 **31-8-104. Fees.**

12

13 Every applicant for an identification card shall pay ~~ten~~
14 ~~dollars (\$10.00)~~ twenty dollars (\$20.00) to the department.
15 The state treasurer shall credit identification card fees
16 to the highway fund.

18 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2008.
