3	hospitalization costs; limiting authority to seek recovery
4	of costs from patients as specified; and providing for an

7	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
8	
9	Section 1. W.S. 25-10-112(d) is amended to read:
10	
11	25-10-112. Liability for costs of detention,
12	involuntary hospitalization and proceedings therefor.

1	(d) The hospital or other treatment provider shall
2	attempt to recover all costs of treatment from public and
3	private health insurance, from patients, and from
4	government benefit programs prior to seeking payment from
5	the county or the department. <u>If the patient has been</u>
6	diagnosed as actually or potentially seriously and
7	persistently mentally ill and the patient's income is at or
8	below two hundred percent (200%) of the federal poverty
9	level, the hospital or other treatment provider shall limit
10	its treatment cost recovery attempts with the patient to
11	not more than three (3) contacts with the patient.

13	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2009.
