A BILL

1	AN ACT relating to mental health and substance abuse
2	services; providing appropriations; specifying conditions;
3	authorizing a competitive bid process as specified;
4	identifying the regions designated by the department of
5	health; and providing for an effective date.
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7	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
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9	Section 1. Co-occurring conditions treatment
10	facilities.
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12	(a) There is appropriated three million six hundred forty-
13	six thousand nine hundred forty dollars (\$3,646,940.00), or

as much thereof as necessary, from the general fund to the 1 2 department of health, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009 and ending June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall 3 only be expended for the purpose of funding four (4) 4 5 treatment facilities. The appropriation shall be used to fund one (1) treatment facility each within the central, 6 7 west, northeast and Basin regions, as designated by the department, to serve persons with co-occurring disorders of 8 mental illness and alcohol or substance abuse. 9 The 10 facility in each region shall be selected by the department 11 of health, in consultation with the mental health and 12 substance abuse services division, through a competitive 13 bid process. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, 14 this appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds 15 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided 16 by law on June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall be 17 18 included in the department's 2011-2012 standard biennial 19 budget request.

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21 (b) The treatment facility selected in each region 22 specified in subsection (a) of this section shall receive 23 nine hundred eleven thousand seven hundred thirty-five

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dollars (\$911,735.00), or as much thereof as necessary, to 1 2 be expended as follows: 3 4 Not more than forty-four thousand dollars (i) 5 (\$44,000.00), shall be allowed for reasonable start-up 6 costs; 7 (ii) Of the remaining amount, not more than ten 8 9 percent (10%) may be used to fund administrative costs for 10 the treatment facility; and 11 12 (iii) The remaining amount after paragraphs (i) 13 and (ii) of this subsection are deducted shall be expended 14 for personnel, equipment and for the operation of the 15 program based on a daily rate established by the department 16 of health. 17 Section 2. Adult acute psychiatric care. 18 19 There is appropriated three million five hundred thousand 20 21 dollars (\$3,500,000.00), or as much thereof as necessary, 22 from the general fund to the department of health, for the 23 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009 and ending June 30,

This appropriation shall only be expended for the 1 2010. 2 purpose of funding five (5) adult acute psychiatric care 3 programs. The appropriation shall be used to fund one (1) treatment facility within each of the five (5) regions, as 4 5 designated by the department. The facility in each region 6 selected by the department of health, in consultation with 7 the mental health and substance abuse services division, through a competitive bid process shall receive not more 8 than seven hundred thousand dollars (\$700,000.00) to 9 10 provide adult acute psychiatry care within the region. any other provision of 11 Notwithstanding law, this appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any 12 13 other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds 14 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall be 15 included in the department's 2011-2012 standard biennial 16 budget request. 17

25 Section 3. Mental health crisis stabilization.

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(a) There is appropriated five hundred fifty thousand 1 2 dollars (\$550,000.00), or as much thereof as necessary, 3 from the general fund to the department of health, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009 and ending June 30, 4 5 This appropriation shall only be expended for the 2010. 6 purpose of developing and enhancing mental health crisis 7 stabilization services provided within the southwest region designated by the department of health. The facility 8 9 receiving this appropriation in the region shall be 10 selected by the department of health, in consultation with 11 the mental health and substance abuse services division, 12 through a competitive bid process. Notwithstanding any 13 other provision of law, this appropriation shall not be 14 transferred or expended for any other purpose and any 15 unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 16 This appropriation shall be included in 17 2010. the 18 department's 2011-2012 standard biennial budget request.

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20 (b) There is appropriated six hundred sixty thousand 21 dollars (\$660,000.00), or as much thereof as necessary, 22 from the general fund to the department of health, for the 23 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009 and ending June 30,

This appropriation shall only be expended for the 1 2010. 2 purpose of developing and enhancing mental health crisis stabilization services provided within the northeast region 3 designated by the department of health. The facility 4 5 receiving this appropriation in the region shall be 6 selected by the department of health, in consultation with 7 the mental health and substance abuse services division, through a competitive bid process. Notwithstanding any 8 9 other provision of law, this appropriation shall not be 10 transferred or expended for any other purpose and any 11 unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this 12 appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 13 2010. This appropriation shall be included in the 14 department's 2011-2012 standard biennial budget request.

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16 There is appropriated five hundred sixty-five (C) thousand four hundred dollars (\$565,400.00), or as much 17 18 thereof as necessary, from the general fund to the department of health, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 19 2009 and ending June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall 20 21 expended for the purpose of developing only be and 22 enhancing mental health crisis stabilization services 23 provided within the central region designated by the

1 department of health. The facility receiving this 2 appropriation in the region shall be selected by the 3 department of health, in consultation with the mental health and substance abuse services division, through a 4 5 competitive bid process. Notwithstanding any other 6 provision of law, this appropriation shall not be 7 transferred or expended for any other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining 8 from this 9 appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 10 2010. This appropriation shall be included in the 11 department's 2011-2012 standard biennial budget request.

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13 (d) There is appropriated seven hundred seventy 14 thousand dollars (\$770,000.00), or as much thereof as 15 necessary, from the general fund to the department of 16 health, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009 and 17 ending June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall only be 18 expended for the purpose of developing and enhancing mental health crisis stabilization services provided within the 19 20 Basin region designated by the department of health. The 21 facility receiving this appropriation in the region shall be selected by the department of health, in consultation 22 23 with the mental health and substance abuse services

1 division, through a competitive bid process. 2 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any 3 other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds 4 5 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall be 6 7 included in the department's 2011-2012 standard biennial budget request. 8

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10 (e) There is appropriated four hundred fifty-eight 11 thousand dollars (\$458,000.00), or as much thereof as 12 necessary, from the general fund to the department of 13 health, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009 and 14 ending June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall only be expended for the purpose of developing and enhancing mental 15 health crisis stabilization services provided within the 16 southeast region designated by the department of health. 17 The facility receiving this appropriation in the region 18 19 shall be selected by the department of health, in consultation with the mental health and substance abuse 20 21 services division, through a competitive bid process. 22 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this 23 appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any

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other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds
remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided
by law on June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall be
included in the department's 2011-2012 standard biennial
budget request.

* * * 6 STAFF COMMENTS *** 7 The southeast region has already received funding 8 for crisis stabilization for the biennium. The 9 southeast region is asking for an additional 10 \$458,000.00 for the program it has been 11 operating, as provided in subsection (e) of this 12 section. 13

14 Section 4. Early intervention therapists.

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16 There is appropriated seven hundred thousand dollars 17 (\$700,000.00), or as much thereof as necessary, from the 18 general fund to the department of health, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009 and ending June 30, 2010. This 19 20 appropriation shall only be expended for the purpose of contracting with providers in the five (5) regions 21 designated by the department of health to allow the 22 contracting providers to hire a total of not more than ten 23 24 (10) additional early intervention therapists in the state. 25 All providers receiving this any amount of this 26 appropriation shall be selected by the department of 27 health, in consultation with the mental health and

substance abuse services division, through a competitive 1 2 bid process. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for 3 any other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds 4 5 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall be 6 7 included in the department's 2011-2012 standard biennial budget request. 8

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10 Section 5. Supported independence program.

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12 There is appropriated two hundred sixty thousand dollars 13 (\$260,000.00), or as much thereof as necessary, from the 14 general fund to the department of health, for the fiscal 15 year beginning July 1, 2009 and ending June 30, 2010. This 16 appropriation shall only be expended for the purpose of funding a supported independence program within a single 17 18 region designated by the department of health. The facility receiving this appropriation in the region shall 19 be selected by the department of health, in consultation 20 21 with the mental health and substance abuse services 22 division, through a competitive bid process. 23 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this

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1 appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any 2 other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds 3 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided 4 by law on June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall be one-5 time funding and shall not be included in the department's 6 2011-2012 standard biennial budget request.

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8 Section 6. Salary increases; substance abuse 9 providers.

10 (a) There is appropriated one million three hundred 11 fifty-nine thousand five hundred twenty-two dollars 12 (\$1,359,522.00), or as much thereof as is necessary, from 13 the general fund to the department of health, substance 14 abuse division, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009 15 and ending June 30, 2010.

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17 (b) The appropriation under this section shall be 18 distributed to community substance abuse treatment centers 19 under contract with the division and shall only be expended 20 by the community substance abuse treatment centers to 21 increase the salaries of direct care personnel in community 22 substance abuse treatment centers. This appropriation

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shall be one-time funding and shall not be included in the 1 2 department's 2011-2012 standard biennial budget request. *** 3 STAFF COMMENTS *** 4 appropriation and Section This the 7 5 appropriation, below, are identical to what was 6 enacted as part of 07SF76. Salary increases; mental health providers. 15 16 (a) There is appropriated one million eight hundred twenty-six thousand one hundred forty-eight dollars 17 18 (\$1,826,148.00), or as much thereof as is necessary, from 19 the general fund to the department of health, mental health division, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009 and 20 21 ending June 30, 2010. 22 23 (b) The appropriation under this section shall be distributed to community mental health centers under 24 contract with the division and shall only be expended by 25 the community mental health centers to increase the 26 27 salaries of direct care personnel in community mental

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health centers. This appropriation shall be one-time

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funding and shall not be included in the department's 2011-1 2 2012 standard biennial budget request. 3 Section 8 Regions of the state. 4 5 6 (a) For purposes of this act, the five (5) regions of 7 the state designated by the department of health include: 8 9 The southeast region; (i) 10 11 (ii) The central region; 12 13 (iii) The northeast region; 14 15 (iv) The west region; and 16 17 (v) The Basin region. 18 19 Section 9 This act is effective July 1, 2009 20 21 (END)
