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5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 7 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-7-110(a) by creating a new
- 8 paragraph (xxviii) and by renumbering paragraph (xxviii)
- 9 as (xxix) and 35-7-124(a) and (b) are amended to read:

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11 **35-7-110.** Definitions.

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13 (a) As used in this act:

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2 (xxviii) "Limited processing" means the

3 processing of a raw agricultural product which does not

4 alter its natural state;

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9 35-7-124. License required; exemptions; electronic

10 transmittals.

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(a) Any person processing, distributing, storing or 12 preparing any food for wholesale or retail use sale or 13 14 distribution to the general public shall obtain a license 15 from the department of agriculture or a local health department. The license is not transferable, shall be 16 17 renewed on an annual basis and shall be prominently displayed in the establishment. No food establishment shall 18 serve, hold for sale or sell food to the public without a 19 valid license. An agricultural producer shall be exempt 20 21 from the licensure requirement in this section for limited

processing, distributing, storing or sale of any raw

agricultural commodity he produces.

2	(b) written application for a new license shall be
3	made on a form approved by the department of agriculture
4	and provided by the department of agriculture or the local
5	health department and shall be signed by the applicant. An
6	initial license fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) shall
7	accompany each application. The license fee for a temporary
8	food event shall be twenty five dollars (\$25.00) which
9	event shall not exceed fourteen (14) days. License
10	requirements and fees for temporary food events operated by
11	nonprofit organizations shall be waived. Licenses shall
12	expire one (1) year after the date of issuance unless
13	suspended or revoked. Licenses may be renewed each year
14	upon application to the department or local health
15	department. accompanied by a fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00).
16	Any establishment which has a license on the effective date
17	of this section shall pay a fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00)
18	for the following year and shall not be liable to pay the
19	initial license fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00). The
20	director shall establish license categories and fees by
21	rule and no fee shall exceed two hundred dollars (\$200.00).

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2009.
