Destruction of feral livestock. 18 19 20 (a) Before any livestock can be declared feral, a 21 reasonable attempt shall be made by the director or the

state veterinarian to locate and identify the owner of the

1 livestock and to notify the owner to take possession of the

4 (b) If the state veterinarian or the director are

5 unable to identify and notify the owner of the livestock or

6 the owner refused to take possession for the livestock

7 within three (3) days, the livestock shall be declared to

8 be feral livestock.

10 (c) If the director or the state veterinarian

11 determines that any feral livestock are damaging private or

12 public property, including grass, cultivated crops or

13 stored crops, or determines the feral livestock is on

14 private or public property where the feral livestock are

15 not authorized to be and that capturing the feral livestock

16 is not feasible or is cost prohibitive, the director or the

17 state veterinarian shall order the destruction of the feral

18 livestock.

20 (d) If the state veterinarian determines or suspects

21 any feral livestock are likely to be infected with or able

22 to spread any infectious or contagious disease, the state

- 1 veterinarian shall order the destruction of the feral
- 2 livestock.

- 4 (e) There shall be no right for any future indemnity
- 5 or payment to the owner for the destruction of any feral
- 6 livestock destroyed in accordance with this section.
- 7 Should the owner of any feral livestock destroyed in
- 8 accordance with this section be subsequently identified,
- 9 the board may seek reimbursement from the owner for all
- 10 costs associated with the destruction and removal of the
- 11 feral livestock.

- 13 (f) The Wyoming livestock board shall promulgate
- 14 rules necessary for the administration of this section.

- 16 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
- 17 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
