7	11-20-401. Brand inspection fees generally.

9	(a) Except as otherwise provided, each livestock
10	inspector shall at the time of inspecting for brands and
11	ownership collect inspection fees in an amount established
12	by the livestock board but not less than:

14	(ii) Twenty-five cents (\$0.25) per head on all
15	sheep, goats, llamas and alpacas, including any hide or
16	carcass;
