1 2 (b) Nothing in this section shall prohibit: 3 4 (i) Any normal or accepted agricultural 5 management practice; 6 7 (ii) Any elk feeding program authorized or conducted by the department; 8 9 (iii) Any legal form of taking elk as provided 10 11 in W.S. 23-1-705(j) or baiting elk as authorized by 12 commission rule and regulation; 13 14 (iv) Any feeding of elk for the purpose of 15 reducing the opportunity for contact with livestock when 16 undertaken with prior notice to the department. 17 (c) A violation of this section constitutes a high 18 misdemeanor punishable as provided in W.S. 23-6-202(a)(ii). 19 20 21 Section 2.
