A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to school finance; continuing specified off-model school district financial assistance programs; 2 imposing reporting requirements upon the department of 3 education; modifying specified assistance amounts; 4 providing appropriations; and providing for effective 5 6 dates. 7 8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 9 Section 1. 2008 Wyoming Session Laws, chapter 95, 10 section 1101(a) through (e) is amended to read: 11 12 13 Section 1101. 14

1 (a) supplemental financial assistance The 2 pilot project for student enrichment instruction is established. Under the project the department 3 of education may provide financial assistance in 4 5 addition to the education resource block grant 6 model for selected districts for the provision of 7 student enrichment instruction programs during the 2008 and 2009 summer school session sessions. 8 9 The project shall meet program requirements and 10 criteria established by rule and regulation of 11 the department.

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13 (b) Each school district may apply to the 14 department of education for assistance under this 15 section on or before April 15, 2008, and on or before April 15, 2009 for the 2009 summer school 16 17 session or the 2009-2010 school year, as 18 applicable. Application shall be on a form and 19 in a manner prescribed by the department. At 20 minimum, the application shall include а 21 description of program content including 22 enrichment learning strategies to be employed.

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1 (C) The department shall notify each 2 district of its eligibility to submit an 3 application to be considered for assistance under 4 this section for a pilot project no later than 5 May 1, 2008. For the 2009 summer school session, notification to school districts shall be 6 7 provided by May 1, 2009. The department shall the notice to the districts the 8 state in 9 application program requirements and shall award funding for selected districts to implement a 10 11 summer school enrichment pilot program. On or 12 2008 or May 31, 2009, as before May 31, 13 applicable, the department shall distribute 14 assistance to each district selected to 15 participate in the summer school pilot enrichment project under this section. 16

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18 (d) Four hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$450,000.00) is appropriated from the public 19 20 school foundation program account to the 21 department of education to be expended as 22 necessary to implement this section. This 23 appropriation shall be for the period beginning

1	with the effective date of this section and
2	ending June 30, 2009. <u>To continue supplemental</u>
3	assistance for student enrichment instruction in
4	the 2009 summer school session and into the
5	2009-2010 school year, four hundred fifty
6	thousand dollars (\$450,000.00) is appropriated
7	from the public school foundation program account
8	to the department of education for the period
9	commencing on the effective date of this
10	subsection and ending June 30, 2010.

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12 (e) Each recipient district shall report by October 1, 2008, or by October 1, 2009, as 13 14 applicable, to the department of education on 15 expenditures of amounts distributed under this section together with additional information 16 17 required by the department on enrichment 18 strategies employed by the district, the impact of the program on student performance and an 19 evaluation of the effectiveness of the enrichment 20 21 strategies employed by the recipient district. 22 If the recipient district received student 23 enrichment assistance for the 2008 summer school

1	session or the 2008-2009 school year, and the
2	2009 summer school session or the 2009-2010
3	school year, the report shall include an analysis
4	and evaluation of program impact on student
5	performance and enrichment strategies over the
6	combined two (2) year period. The department
7	shall compile the information reported by
8	districts under this subsection, and report to
9	the joint education interim committee, together
10	with program recommendations, on or before
11	December 1, 2008, and on or before December 1,
12	2009 for programs funded in the 2009 summer
13	session and 2009-2010 school year. Program
14	recommendations shall also address 2010 model
15	recalibration and provide recommendations on
16	future enrichment program funding as a cost-based
17	component of the block grant model or
18	continuation as an off-model categorical
19	assistance program.

6 (e) The amount of assistance for each 7 qualifying applicant district under this section shall be the lesser of the total amount of the 8 9 funding deficit experienced by that district for 10 the school year immediately preceding the year of 11 application, or an amount determined by 12 multiplying the per meal reimbursement computed 13 for the school year of application under 14 subsection (d) of this section times the number 15 of qualifying meals reported by the applicant district under subsection (c) of this section. 16 17 Payments for each qualifying district shall be 18 made by the department not later than October 15 of the school year of application. 19

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(b) For the period beginning July 1, 2009, and ending
June 30, 2010, four million five hundred thousand dollars
(\$4,500,000.00) is appropriated from the public school

foundation program account to the department of education 1 2 to continue financial assistance to school districts for food service programs as provided under 2008 Wyoming 3 Session Laws, chapter 95, section 601. Program rules and 4 5 regulations adopted under 2008 Wyoming Session Laws, chapter 95, section 602 for school year 2008-2009 shall 6 7 apply to school year 2009-2010, and reporting requirements imposed under 2008 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 95, 8 9 Section 601(f) shall be expanded to evaluate program impact and effectiveness over the combined two (2) year period 10 11 including school years 2008-2009 and 2009-2010.

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13 Section 3. Five million eight hundred ninety-four 14 thousand three hundred six dollars (\$5,894,306.00) is appropriated from the public school foundation program 15 16 account to the department of education, to be expended only to augment amounts within the department's budget for the 17 18 supplemental funding program for instructional facilitators 19 and instructional coaches pursuant to W.S. 21-13-335. This appropriation shall be for the period beginning July 1, 20 2009, and ending June 30, 2010. 21

23 Section 4.

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(a) Except as provided by subsection (b) of this 2 3 section, this act is effective July 1, 2009. 4 (b) Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this section, 5 section 1 of this act is effective immediately upon 6 7 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 8 9 Constitution. 10
