## A BILL

## for

1 AN ACT relating to the clean coal task force; extending the 2 existence of the clean coal task force as specified; requiring annual reports; authorizing funding of proposals 3 from appropriations from abandoned mine land funds as 4 5 specified; reappropriating funds to be used for clean coal 6 research; providing an appropriation; and providing for an 7 effective date. 8 9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 10

11 Section 1. W.S. 21-17-121 is created to read:

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(a) The clean coal research task force created 1 pursuant to 2007 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 186, Section 2 2 shall exist until June 30, 2013. . The task force shall 3 4 consist of the members of the Wyoming energy resources 5 council created pursuant to W.S. 21-17-117(e), or their 6 designees. 7 The task force shall meet at the call of the 8 (b) 9 The task force shall chairman. issue requests for 10 proposals for research projects into clean coal 11 technologies. The task force shall review and evaluate 12 proposals for research into clean coal technologies, 13 subject to the following: 14 15 (i) Proposals may be received from academic 16 institutions and private industry proponents; 17 18 (ii) Proposals shall be evaluated competitively 19 on their probable benefits to the state of Wyoming and coal programs within this state; 20

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(iii) Proposals shall enhance and improve clean
coal technologies with an emphasis on methods of combusting
sub-bituminous coal at high altitudes.

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5 The task force shall issue a report to the (C) 6 governor and the joint minerals, business and economic 7 development interim committee annually, no later than 30, including, but limited 8 September not to, 9 recommendations regarding funding specific proposals for research into clean coal technologies in Wyoming. 10

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12 (d) The task force shall be staffed by the governor's 13 office with support from the University of Wyoming school 14 of energy resources. The task force may contract for 15 administrative and research services to aid in preparation 16 of the task force report.

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(e) Members of the task force who are not legislators shall not receive a salary but shall receive reimbursement for necessary travel and per diem expenses in the manner and amount provided for state employees under W.S. 9-3-102 and 9-3-103. Members of the task force who are legislators shall be paid salary, per diem and travel expenses as

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provided in W.S. 28-5-101 for their official duties as 1 2 members of the task force. 3 4 (f) The clean coal task force may award funding 5 appropriated from abandoned mine land funds to proposals 6 for clean coal after submitting the task force's 7 recommendations to the joint minerals, business and 8 economic development interim committee for review and 9 comment. [Staff Note: This may change as a result of the federal 10 11 rule published June 20, 2008. Are these funds appropriated 12 generically and not for a specific project?] 13 Section 2. W.S. 39-14-802(b) is amended to read: 14 15 16 39-14-802. Clean coal research account created; funds 17 deposited; use of funds. 18 Deposits into the account created by subsection 19 (b) shall only be expended upon 20 (a) of this section 21 appropriation by the legislature. Funds deposited in the account shall not be expended until a dollar for dollar 22 23 match has been provided from nonstate funds.

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1 2 Section 3. 2008 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 48, 3 Section 320(a)(vii) is amended to read: 4 5 Section 320. 6 7 (a) No application to the federal office of 8 surface mining for grants from the state of 9 Wyoming's share of abandoned mine land funds from the Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act 10 11 Amendments of 2006, Section 411(h)(i), pursuant to 2007 H.R. 6111, shall be made except as 12 13 expressly authorized by the legislature. The 14 legislature authorizes the department of 15 environmental quality to submit grant applications to the federal office of surface 16 17 mining for distribution of a portion of such funds for the period ending June 30, 2009, for 18 the following projects: 19 20 21 million eight (vii) Three hundred thousand dollars (\$3,800,000.00) for clean coal 22 23 technology research to be deposited into the

1 account created under W.S. 39-14-802 to be 2 expended pursuant to 2007 Wyoming Session Laws, 3 Chapter 186, Section 2(f) as created in Section <del>325 of this act W.S.</del> 21-17-121(f) and as 4 5 restricted by W.S. 39-14-802(b) for the purpose 6 of clean coal technology research. 7 8 Section 4. 2007 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 186, 9 Sections 2 and 3 and 2008 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 48, 10 Section 325(b), Section 3(b) are repealed. 11 12 Section 5. 13 14 (a) Any funds remaining from the appropriation provided in 2007 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 186, Section 15 16 3(b), as amended by 2008 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 48, Section 325(b) are hereby reappropriated to the account 17 18 created under W.S. 39-14-802 for the purpose of clean coal technology research. Notwithstanding W.S. 9-2-1008 or 19 9-4-207, unexpended funds shall not revert on June 30, 20 21 2010.

1 (b) Any funds remaining under the appropriation 2 provided in 2007 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 186, Section 3 3(a) are hereby reappropriated to the governor's office for 4 expenses incurred by the clean coal task force.

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6 (c) There is appropriated ten thousand dollars 7 (\$10,000.00) from the general fund to the legislative 8 service office for compensation of legislative members 9 serving on the clean coal task force.

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11 (d) Funds appropriated under subsections (b) and (c) 12 of this section are appropriated. This appropriation shall 13 be for the period beginning with the effective date of this 14 act and ending June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall only be expended for the purpose of staffing the clean coal 15 16 task force and for expenses incurred by the clean coal task 17 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this force. appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any 18 any unexpended, unobligated funds 19 other purpose and 20 remaining from this appropriation shall not revert as provided by law on June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall 21 22 be included in the governor's and the legislative service 23 office's 2011-2012 standard biennial budget requests.

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Section 6. This act is effective immediately upon 2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 4 5 Constitution. 6 7 (END)
