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7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 9 **Section 1.** W.S. 39-13-109(c)(iv)(A), (B)(intro), (IV)
- 10 and by creating a new subdivision (VI) is amended to read:

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12 39-13-109. Taxpayer remedies.

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14 (c) Refunds. The following shall apply:

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1 (iv) The following shall apply to the property

2 tax refund program:

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(A) On or before the first Monday in June, 4 5 upon the filing of an affidavit demonstrating an adequate showing that he is qualified under subparagraph (B) or (C) 6 of this paragraph, any person may apply to the county 7 treasurer or department of revenue for a property tax 8 9 refund from property taxes timely paid on or before the 10 first Monday in June for the preceding calendar year upon 11 his principal residence including the land upon which the is located. An applicant shall have been a 12 residence 13 resident of this state for not less than five (5) years prior to applying for a refund under this paragraph. 14 Subject to legislative appropriation, the affidavit shall 15 include information as required by rule and regulation on a 16 17 form approved by the department of revenue. The tax refund granted shall be as provided by subparagraph (C) of this 18

21 (B) Gross income as used in this 22 subparagraph shall be defined by the department through 23 rules and regulations. Such gross income shall be verified 24 by federal income tax returns which shall accompany the

1 application for refund, if federal income tax returns were required and filed, or whatever other means necessary as 2 determined by the department through rules and regulations. 3 4 The tax refund for qualifying persons shall be in the form 5 of a refund of any ad valorem tax due and timely paid upon the person's principal residence for the preceding calendar 6 in the amount specified in this paragraph. 7 department shall issue all refunds due under this paragraph 8 9 on or before September 30 of the year in which application 10 is made for the refund. Any person shall qualify for a 11 refund in the amount specified under this paragraph if the person's gross income including the total household income 12 13 of which the person is a member does not exceed the greater 14 of two thirds (2/3) three-fourths (3/4) of the median gross household income for the applicant's county of residence or 15 the state, as determined annually by the economic analysis 16 17 division of the department of administration Additionally, no person shall qualify for a 18 information. refund under this paragraph unless the person has total 19 20 household assets as defined by the department of revenue 21 through rules and regulations of not to exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) one hundred thousand dollars 22 23 (\$100,000.00) per adult member of the household as adjusted 24 annually by the statewide average Wyoming cost-of-living
