Certificate of restoration of rights; procedure for 11 restoration in general; procedure for 12 restoration of voting rights for nonviolent felonies; filing requirements. 13 14 15 (b) A person convicted of a nonviolent felony or

nonviolent felonies arising out of the same occurrence or

related course of events may apply in writing to the state 1 2 board of parole for a certificate which restores the 3 person's voting rights lost pursuant to W.S. 6-10-106. The 4 application shall specifically state that the requirements 5 of this subsection have been met and shall be on a form approved by the state board of parole. The state board of 6 7 parole shall issue a certificate restoring a person's voting rights if: 8 9 10 (iii) It has been at least five (5) years one 11 (1) year since the expiration of all of the applicant's 12 terms of sentence, or in the case of probation, the 13 completion of all probation periods. 14 15 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2009. 16 17 (END)
