Notification of blood borne pathogens.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to emergency medical services; providing  
2 that the department of health supply and require ambulances  
3 to carry blood borne pathogen disinfectant and information  
4 packets; providing an appropriation; and providing for an  
5 effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 33-36-103 by creating a new  
10 subsection (d) is amended to read:

11

12 **33-36-103. Rules and regulations; procedure;**  
13 **initiation of proceedings.**

15 (d) Rules adopted by the division pursuant to this  
16 section shall require that all ambulances carry on board an

1 appropriate pathogen disinfectant for use by any person on  
2 the scene of an emergency who may have been exposed to a  
3 blood borne pathogen, along with written information  
4 packets regarding the proper use of the disinfectant and  
5 any follow up medical care or testing. The division shall  
6 maintain an inventory of appropriate disinfectant and  
7 information packets for use by licensed ambulance services.

8  
9       **Section 2.** There is appropriated fifty thousand  
10 dollars (\$50,000.00) from the general fund to the  
11 department of health. This appropriation shall be for the  
12 period beginning with the effective date of this act and  
13 ending June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall only be  
14 expended for the purpose of acquiring blood borne pathogen  
15 disinfectant and information packets pursuant to W.S.  
16 33-36-103(d) created by this act. Notwithstanding any  
17 other provision of law, this appropriation shall not be  
18 transferred or expended for any other purpose and any  
19 unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this  
20 appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30,  
21 2010. This appropriation shall be included in the  
22 department's 2011-2012 standard biennial budget request.

1       **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2009.
