6	Section 1. W.S. 1-1-131 is created to read:

8	1-1-131. Duties of worksite owners.
9	
10	(a) An owner of a worksite owes a nondelegable duty
11	of reasonable care to an employee of an independent
12	contractor if the owner retains the right to direct the
13	manner of the independent contractor's performance or
14	assumes affirmative duties with respect to safety. This
15	duty is a question of law that can arise from statute,
16	regulations, contract and common law. Contracts, statutes,

regulations or common law which call for an owner to 1 2 exercise reasonable diligence having regard for the health and safety of workmen or employees create a duty of 3 4 reasonable care. 5 (b) No contract, rule, regulation, agreement 6 or device shall operate to relieve a worksite owner from any 7 duty established in subsection (a) of this section. 8 9 (c) For purposes of this section, "owner of a 10 worksite" shall mean the person who has the right to 11 12 control the workplace. 13 14 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2009. 15 16 (END)
