Mental health and substance abuse appropriations.

Sponsored by: Select Committee on Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services

A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to mental health and substance abuse
- 2 services; providing appropriations; specifying conditions;
- 3 authorizing a competitive bid process as specified;
- 4 identifying the regions designated by the department of
- 5 health for purposes of certain appropriations; and
- 6 providing for an effective date.

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8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 10 Section 1. Mental health services for infants and
- 11 children.

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- 13 There is appropriated seven hundred thousand dollars
- 14 (\$700,000.00), or as much thereof as necessary, from the
- 15 general fund to the department of health, for the fiscal
- 16 year beginning July 1, 2009 and ending June 30, 2010. The

1 funds appropriated under this section shall only be used by 2 community mental health centers to contract with the 3 equivalent of not more than ten (10) full-time master's 4 degree level therapists. The persons under contract with 5 community mental health centers pursuant to this section shall provide early intervention services for families with 6 preschool age children who are experiencing or are at risk 7 behavioral, mental or alcohol or substance abuse 8 9 disorders. Funds under this section shall only be 10 distributed to community mental health centers that have 11 established interagency collaborations within the region designated by the division in which the center is located 12 13 to provide early intervention services as specified in this 14 subsection. Community mental health centers receiving funds under this section shall only expend the funds to 15 contract with therapists as authorized by this section. 16 17 Any funds unobligated and unexpended under this section on June 30, 2010, shall revert to the budget reserve account. 18 This appropriation shall be included in the department's 19 20 2011-2012 standard budget request.

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22 Section 2. Supported independence program.

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1 There is appropriated two hundred sixty thousand dollars 2 (\$260,000.00), or as much thereof as necessary, from the general fund to the department of health, for the fiscal 3 4 year beginning July 1, 2009 and ending June 30, 2010. This 5 appropriation shall only be expended for the purpose of funding a supported independence program within a single 6 region designated by the department of health. The program 7 receiving this appropriation in the region shall be 8 9 selected by the department of health, in consultation with 10 the mental health and substance abuse services division, 11 through a competitive bid process. Notwithstanding any 12 other provision of law, this appropriation shall not be 13 transferred or expended for any other purpose and any 14 unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 15 16 appropriation shall be included in 2010. This the 17 department's 2011-2012 standard biennial budget request.

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19 Section 3. Mental health crisis stabilization.

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21 (a) There is appropriated five hundred fifty thousand 22 dollars (\$550,000.00), or as much thereof as necessary, 23 from the general fund to the department of health, for the 24 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009 and ending June 30,

1 2010. This appropriation shall only be expended for the 2 purpose of developing and enhancing mental health crisis 3 stabilization services provided within the southwest region 4 designated by the department of health. The program 5 receiving this appropriation in the region shall be selected by the department of health, in consultation with 6 7 the mental health and substance abuse services division, through a competitive bid process. Notwithstanding any 8 9 other provision of law, this appropriation shall not be 10 transferred or expended for any other purpose and any 11 unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 12 13 2010. This appropriation shall be included in 14 department's 2011-2012 standard biennial budget request. 15 There is appropriated six hundred sixty thousand (b) dollars (\$660,000.00), or as much thereof as necessary,

16 17 from the general fund to the department of health, for the 18 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009 and ending June 30, 19 20 This appropriation shall only be expended for the 21 purpose of developing and enhancing mental health crisis 22 stabilization services provided within the northeast region designated by the department of health. 23 The program 24 receiving this appropriation in the region shall

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1 selected by the department of health, in consultation with

2 the mental health and substance abuse services division,

3 through a competitive bid process. Notwithstanding any

4 other provision of law, this appropriation shall not be

5 transferred or expended for any other purpose and any

funds remaining 6 unexpended, unobligated from this

7 appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30,

2010. This appropriation shall be 8 included in the

9 department's 2011-2012 standard biennial budget request.

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11 There is appropriated five hundred sixty-five (C) thousand four hundred dollars (\$565,400.00), or as much 12 13 thereof as necessary, from the general fund to 14 department of health, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009 and ending June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall 15 only be expended for the purpose of developing and 16 17 enhancing mental health crisis stabilization services provided within the central region designated by the 18 department of health. The program receiving this 19 20 appropriation in the region shall be selected by the 21 department of health, in consultation with the mental 22 health and substance abuse services division, through a competitive bid process. Notwithstanding any other 23

provision of law, this appropriation shall

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not

1 transferred or expended for any other purpose and any

2 unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this

3 appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30,

4 This appropriation shall be included in the

5 department's 2011-2012 standard biennial budget request.

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(d)

There

is appropriated seven hundred thousand dollars (\$770,000.00), or as much thereof 8 9 necessary, from the general fund to the department of 10 health, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009 and 11 ending June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall only be expended for the purpose of developing and enhancing mental 12 13 health crisis stabilization services provided within the 14 Basin region designated by the department of health. 15 program receiving this appropriation in the region shall be 16 selected by the department of health, in consultation with 17 the mental health and substance abuse services division, through a competitive bid process. Notwithstanding any 18 19 other provision of law, this appropriation shall not be 20 transferred or expended for any other purpose and any 21 unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this 22 appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30, be included This 23 2010. appropriation shall in the 24 department's 2011-2012 standard biennial budget request.

2	(e) There is appropriated four hundred fifty-eight
3	thousand dollars (\$458,000.00), or as much thereof as
4	necessary, from the general fund to the department of
5	health, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009 and
6	ending June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall only be
7	expended for the purpose of developing and enhancing mental
8	health crisis stabilization services provided within the
9	southeast region designated by the department of health.
LO	The program receiving this appropriation in the region
L1	shall be selected by the department of health, ir
L2	consultation with the mental health and substance abuse
L3	services division, through a competitive bid process.
L4	Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this
L5	appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any
L6	other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds
L7	remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided
L8	by law on June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall be
L9	included in the department's 2011-2012 standard biennial
20	budget request.

Section 4. Adult acute psychiatric care.

1 There is appropriated three million five hundred thousand 2 dollars (\$3,500,000.00), or as much thereof as necessary, 3 from the general fund to the department of health, for the 4 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009 and ending June 30, 5 2010. This appropriation shall only be expended for the purpose of funding five (5) adult acute psychiatric care 6 7 programs. The appropriation shall be used to fund one (1) treatment program within each of the five (5) regions, as 8 9 designated by the department. The program in each region 10 selected by the department of health, in consultation with 11 the mental health and substance abuse services division, through a competitive bid process shall receive not more 12 13 than seven hundred thousand dollars (\$700,000.00) 14 provide adult acute psychiatric care within the region. 15 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any 16 17 other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided 18 by law on June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall be 19 20 included in the department's 2011-2012 standard biennial 21 budget request.

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23 Section 5. Co-occurring conditions treatment

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24 programs.

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2	(a) There is appropriated three million six hundred
3	forty-six thousand nine hundred forty dollars
4	(\$3,646,940.00), or as much thereof as necessary, from the
5	general fund to the department of health, for the fiscal
6	year beginning July 1, 2009 and ending June 30, 2010. This
7	appropriation shall only be expended for the purpose of
8	funding four (4) treatment programs. The appropriation
9	shall be used to fund one (1) treatment program each within
L O	the central, west, northeast and Basin regions, as
L1	designated by the department, to serve persons with co-
L2	occurring disorders of mental illness and alcohol or
L3	substance abuse. The program in each region shall be
L4	selected by the department of health, in consultation with
L5	the mental health and substance abuse services division,
L6	through a competitive bid process. Notwithstanding any
L7	other provision of law, this appropriation shall not be
L8	transferred or expended for any other purpose and any
L9	unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this
20	appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30,
21	2010. This appropriation shall be included in the
22	department's 2011-2012 standard biennial budget request.

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1 (b) The treatment program selected in each region specified in subsection (a) of this section shall receive 2 3 nine hundred eleven thousand seven hundred thirty-five 4 dollars (\$911,735.00), or as much thereof as necessary, to 5 be expended as follows: 6 7 (i) Not more than forty-four thousand dollars 8 (\$44,000.00), shall be allowed for reasonable start-up 9 costs; 10 11 (ii) Of the remaining amount, not more than ten percent (10%) may be used to fund administrative costs for 12 13 the treatment program; and 14 15 (iii) The remaining amount after paragraphs (i) and (ii) of this subsection are deducted shall be expended 16 17 for personnel, equipment and for the operation of the 18 program based on a daily rate established by the department 19 of health. 20 21 Section 6. Salary increases; substance abuse

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providers.

1 (a) There is appropriated one million three hundred

2 fifty-nine thousand five hundred twenty-two dollars

3 (\$1,359,522.00), or as much thereof as is necessary, from

4 the general fund to the department of health for the fiscal

5 year beginning July 1, 2009 and ending June 30, 2010.

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7 (b) The appropriation under this section shall be

8 distributed to community substance abuse treatment centers

9 under contract with the mental health and substance abuse

10 services division and shall only be expended by the

11 community substance abuse treatment centers to increase the

12 salaries of direct care personnel in community substance

13 abuse treatment centers. This appropriation shall be

14 included in the department's 2011-2012 standard biennial

15 budget request.

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17 Section 7. Salary increases; mental health providers.

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19 (a) There is appropriated one million eight hundred

20 twenty-six thousand one hundred forty-eight dollars

21 (\$1,826,148.00), or as much thereof as is necessary, from

22 the general fund to the department of health for the fiscal

23 year beginning July 1, 2009 and ending June 30, 2010.

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1	(b) T	he	appropriation	under	this	section	shall	be
2	distributed	t	o community	mental	healt	th cente	ers un	ıder

3 contract with the mental health and substance abuse

4 services division and shall only be expended by the

5 community mental health centers to increase the salaries of

6 direct care personnel in community mental health centers.

7 This appropriation shall be included in the department's

8 2011-2012 standard biennial budget request.

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10 Section 8. Regions of the state.

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12 (a) For purposes of this act, the five (5) regions of

13 the state designated by the department of health include:

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15 (i) The southeast region, comprised of Albany,

16 Carbon, Goshen, Laramie and Platte counties;

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18 (ii) The central region, comprised of Converse,

19 Fremont, Natrona and Niobrara counties;

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21 (iii) The northeast region, comprised of

22 Campbell, Crook, Johnson, Sheridan and Weston counties;

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1	(iv) The west region, comprised of Lincoln,
2	Sublette, Sweetwater, Teton and Uinta counties; and
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4	(v) The Basin region, comprised of Big Horn, Hot
5	Springs, Park and Washakie counties.
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7	Section 9. This act is effective July 1, 2009.
