A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to improvement and service districts;  
2 providing for formation for limited purposes; providing for  
3 change of purposes; providing clarification of a  
4 definition; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 18-12-102(a)(iv), 18-12-106 and  
9 18-12-112(a)(intro) and (viii) are amended to read:

11 **18-12-102. Definitions.**

13 (a) As used in this act:

14

1 (iv) "Charges" means fees, tolls, rates and  
2 rentals, including charges for operation and maintenance of  
3 any improvement assessed under W.S. 18-12-112(a)(xxi);  
4

5 **18-12-106. Petition for formation; limitation of**  
6 **purpose; change of purpose.**  
7

8 (a) A petition to form a district or to change the  
9 purposes of a district shall be signed by not less than  
10 sixty percent (60%) of the persons owning land within the  
11 territory proposed to be included in the district, whose  
12 land in the proposed district has an assessed value of  
13 sixty percent (60%) or more of the assessed value of all of  
14 the land within the proposed district.  
15

16 (b) A petition for formation of a district may limit  
17 the improvements or services to be provided by the  
18 district. Nothing in this subsection shall limit the  
19 ability to form a district for provision of any or all  
20 improvements or services authorized under W.S. 18-12-112.  
21

22 (c) A petition to change the purposes of a district  
23 shall proceed in accordance with the process for formation  
24 of a district as provided in this article.

**18-12-112. Powers of district.**

(a) Each district may, in accordance with the purposes for which it was created:

(viii) Establish and collect charges for water, sanitation and related services and the use of improvements or services provided by the district, including authority to change the amount or rate ~~thereof~~ of any charges, and to pledge the revenues ~~therefrom~~ from any charges for the payment of district indebtedness;

**Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2010.
