Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 11-18-119(a)(intro) is amended to read:

## 11-18-119. Veterinarian loan repayment program; rulemaking authority.

(a) The board is authorized to enter into agreements with <u>graduate</u> veterinarians who <u>have graduated from</u> <u>accredited veterinary colleges are licensed to practice in</u> <u>the state of Wyoming</u>, to provide food animal health care in this state.
