7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-25-104 is amended to read:

11 35-25-104. Private insurance program benefits.

- 13 A child eligible for services under this act shall receive
- 14 benefits developed by the health benefits committee
- 15 established under W.S. 35-25-105 that include cost sharing
- 16 factors, not to exceed the maximum allowable under Public

1 Law 105-33, exclusions and limitations. The benefit package shall include, at a minimum, inpatient and outpatient 2 hospital services, physician services, laboratory and x-ray 3 4 services, well-baby and well-child care including age 5 appropriate immunizations and the additional services of prescription drug coverage, vision coverage and dental 6 coverage which will include preventive and basic services 7 developed by the health benefits committee. 8 The benefit 9 package shall include a prenatal care benefit option pursuant to 42 C.F.R. section 457.10 and provide for a 10 global payment to health care providers for prenatal, 11 perinatal and postpartum services. For purposes of the 12 13 prenatal care benefit option, "child" includes 14 individual under the age of nineteen (19) including the 15 period from conception to birth.

17 Section 2. There is appropriated eight hundred two thousand dollars (\$802,000.00) from the general fund and 18 one million four hundred eighty-nine thousand dollars 19 (\$1,489,000.00) in federal funds to the department of 20 21 This appropriation shall be for the fiscal 22 biennium beginning July 1, 2010. This appropriation shall only be expended for the purpose of providing prenatal care 23 24 under the child health insurance program pursuant to this

act. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this
appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any
other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds
remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided
by law on June 30, 2012. This appropriation shall be
included in the department's 2013-2014 standard biennial
