Use of force in self defense. 12 (d) A person who is in a place where he has a right 13 to be has no duty to retreat and has the right to stand his 14 ground and meet force with force, including deadly force if 15

1	he reasonably believes it is necessary to do so to prevent
2	death or serious bodily injury to himself or another or to
3	prevent the commission of a violent felony.
