1	(i) The person against whom the defensive force
2	is used has a right to be in or is a lawful resident of the
3	occupied structure home or habitation, such as an owner,
4	lessee or titleholder, and there is not an injunction for
5	protection from domestic violence or a written pretrial
6	supervision order of no contact against that person;

8	(d) As used in this section:
9	
10	(i) "Habitation" means any occupied structure
11	which is designed or adapted for overnight accommodation,
12	including buildings, modular units, trailers, campers and
13	tents;

15	(ii) "Home" means any occupied residential
16	dwelling place.
