- 1 A JOINT RESOLUTION requesting Congress and the President of
- 2 the United States to reverse the policy of the U.S.
- 3 Department of Health and Human Services regarding health
- 4 plan coverage of sterilization, abortifacients and

- 7 WHEREAS, on January 20, 2012 the U.S. Department of Health
- 8 and Human Services reaffirmed a rule that virtually all
- 9 private health care plans must cover sterilization,
- 10 abortifacients and contraception; and

- 12 WHEREAS, through this mandate the administration has
- 13 refused to recognize the Constitutional conscience rights
- 14 of organizations and individuals, thereby launching an

- 1 unprecedented attack on conscience rights and religious
- 2 liberty; and

- 4 WHEREAS, it is unconstitutional for federal government to
- 5 require such facilities, including hospitals and schools,
- 6 to violate their religious beliefs or moral convictions;
- 7 and

- 9 WHEREAS, the mandate threatens the religious freedoms of
- 10 all Americans; and

- 12 WHEREAS, freedom of conscience is a bedrock liberty,
- 13 inherent to the human person created in the image of God,
- 14 not a privilege based on the whim of the state; and

- 16 WHEREAS, it is an injustice to force Americans to choose
- 17 between violating their consciences and forgoing their
- 18 healthcare; and

- 20 WHEREAS, longstanding federal laws expressing the decided
- 21 opinion of Congress and the American people have protected
- 22 Constitutional conscience rights.
