in which the court determines any one (1) or more of the 1 2 following by clear and convincing evidence: that: 3 4 (ii) The parent abandoned, chronically abused, 5 tortured or sexually abused the child; or 6 7 (iv) The parent has been convicted of committing sexual abuse against the child or another child of that 8 9 parent; 10 (v) The parent is required to register with a 11 12 sex offender registry pursuant to the Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act, 42 U.S.C. 16911 et seq. 13 14 Section 2.
