- 10 (a) The board of land commissioners is authorized to
- 11 convey all its right, title and interest in the following
- 12 described parcels of land within the boundaries of the
- 13 Grand Teton National Park to the United States Department
- 14 of the Interior:

- 16 (i) All mineral rights owned by the state in the
- 17 parcel known as the Jackson Lake Parcel containing 39.59

- 1 acres, more or less, and being more particularly described
- 2 as: Section 36: Lot 6, Township 45 North, Range 115 West,
- 3 6th P.M., Teton County, WY;

- 5 (ii) The parcel known as the Snake River Parcel
- 6 containing 86.32 acres, more or less, and being more
- 7 particularly described as: Section 16: Lots 2, 3, 4 and 7,
- 8 Township 42 North, Range 116 West, 6th P.M., Teton County,
- 9 WY;

- 11 (iii) The parcel known as the Antelope Flats
- 12 Parcel containing 640 acres, more or less, and being more
- 13 particularly described as: Section 16, Township 43 North,
- 14 Range 115 West, 6th P.M., Teton County, WY; and

- 16 (iv) The parcel known as the Kelly Parcel on Gros
- 17 Ventre Road containing 640 acres, more or less, and being
- 18 more particularly described as: Section 36, Township 43
- 19 North, Range 115 West, 6th P.M., Teton County, WY.

- 21 (b) The conveyances authorized by subsection (a) of
- 22 this section shall be by sale at not less than appraised
- 23 value, with the terms of the sale to be determined by the

2 (i) A percentage of federal mineral royalties

3 from biogenic gas produced on the parcel; or

5 (ii) The land for the federal unminable coal in

6 Wyoming.

8 (c) Proceeds from the sale shall be deposited to the

9 common school account within the permanent land fund.

11 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon

12 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

13 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

14 Constitution.
