- 12 (c) The division may issue a restricted class "C" or
- 13 "M" license, or both such licenses, to a person who is
- 14 between the ages of fourteen (14) and sixteen (16) years
- 15 upon receipt of application, payment of the proper fees, an
- 16 affidavit of extreme inconvenience signed by the parent or

1	guardian having custody of the applicant and a finding by
2	the highway patrol that extreme inconvenience actually
3	exists. The applicant shall successfully pass the
4	examination required by W.S. 31-7-114. The licensee may
5	drive a vehicle only between the hours of 5:00 a.m. and
6	8:00 11:00 p.m., within a fifty (50) mile radius of his
7	domicile and only at the direction of his parent or
8	guardian. The licensee may transport no more than three (3)
9	passengers under the age of eighteen (18) who are not
10	members of the licensee's immediate family and may do so
11	only at the direction of his parent or guardian. The
12	licensee shall not transport any passenger if operating a
13	<u>motorcycle.</u> If any person while licensed under this
14	subsection, receives a citation for a moving violation, the
15	division, upon receipt of the notice of conviction, shall
16	suspend the license and any other license or permit
17	evidencing that person's privilege to operate a motor
18	vehicle. For purposes of this subsection "extreme
19	inconvenience" includes the following circumstances:
