1 journeyman electrician shall install all electrical equipment. This requirement is waived for the following, 2 3 however the waiver does not exempt the following persons 4 from meeting all other code requirements under this act: 5 (iv) Cable-TV, satellite-TV 6 and telecommunications, including data and related services of 7 cable-TV, satellite-TV and telecommunications providers 8 9 including its contractors and subcontractors provided such the contractors and subcontractors are limited to the 10 installation of low voltage cable, A.M. or F.M. radio 11 stations, television stations, phone services, internet 12 13 services, data services and related services; 14 (x) Low voltage installations, including 15 hardware and cabling, of cable-TV, satellite-TV, sound 16 17 systems, A.M. or F.M. radio services, television service, internet service and telecommunications services, including 18 19 data and related services. 20 21 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2013.
