- 15 party affiliation, or sign an application for change of
- 16 affiliation before he may receive a party ballot. An

1 elector may vote only the nonpartisan ballot and if so, is

2 not required to declare his party affiliation. An elector

may not receive a partisan ballot for a primary election if 3

4 at the time of requesting the ballot he is entered in the

5 pollbook as affiliated with a different political party.

Requesting a partisan primary election ballot constitutes a 6

declaration of party affiliation. A change in declaration 7

of party affiliation resulting from a request for a 8

9 partisan primary election ballot by a previously

10 unaffiliated elector shall be entered on the poll list by

11 the election judge.

A previously unaffiliated elector who votes a partisan 15 primary election ballot shall be entered on the poll list 17 by the election judge. A previously unaffiliated elector may also become affiliated with a party and an affiliated 18 elector may change his party affiliation by completing an 19 20 application signed before a notarial officer or election official, and filing it with the county clerk not later than at any time not within thirty (30) days before the primary election, or at the polls on the day of the primary

or general election, or when requesting an absentee ballot.

If the request for an absentee ballot is made for a 1 2 partisan ballot for a primary election no change in party affiliation shall be made unless the request for the 3 4 absentee ballot is made at least thirty (30) days before the primary election. A change in declaration of party 5 affiliation at a general election shall be entered on the 6 7 poll list by the election judge. 8 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2013. 9 10
