- 8 **Section 1**. W.S. 14-3-204(a)(iii)(intro),
- 9 14-3-206(a)(i) and 35-20-102(a)(xix) are amended to read:

11 14-3-204. Duties of local child protective agency.

13 (a) The local child protective agency shall:

- 15 (iii) Within twenty-four (24) hours after
- 16 notification of a suspected case of child abuse or neglect,
- 17 initiate an investigation or assessment and verification of

1 to verify every report. The representative of the child protective agency shall, at the initial time of contact 2 3 with the individual subject to a child abuse and neglect 4 investigation or assessment, advise the individual of the 5 specific complaints or allegations made against the individual. A thorough investigation or assessment 6 report of child abuse or neglect shall be made in the 7 manner and time prescribed by the state agency pursuant to 8 9 rules and regulations adopted in accordance with the 10 Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act. Ιf the 11 protective agency is denied reasonable access to a child by a parent or other persons and the agency deems that the 12 13 best interest of the child so requires, it shall seek an appropriate court order by ex parte proceedings or other 14 appropriate proceedings to see the child. The 15 child protective agency shall assign a report: 16

22 (a) Reports of child abuse or neglect or of suspected 23 child abuse or neglect made to the local child protective 24 agency or local law enforcement agency shall be:

17	exploitation, intimidation or neglect: exists;
