SIXTY-SECOND LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING 2014 BUDGET SESSION

AN ACT relating to children in need of supervision; increasing the age limit for purposes of children in need of supervision provisions; amending applicability of court orders; amending a definition; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 14-6-402(a)(iv) and 14-6-431(b) are amended to read:

14-6-402. Definitions.

(a) As used in this act:

(iv) "Child in need of supervision" means any child who has not reached his seventeenth eighteenth birthday who is habitually truant or has run away from home or habitually disobeys reasonable and lawful demands of his parents, guardian, custodian or other proper authority or is ungovernable and beyond control. "Child in need of supervision" includes any child who has not reached his seventeenth eighteenth birthday who has committed a status offense;

14-6-431. Duration of orders of disposition; termination of orders.

(b) Unless sooner terminated by court order, all orders issued under this act shall terminate with respect to a child adjudicated in need of supervision when he reaches seventeen (17) eighteen (18) years of age. If the child is still in the custody of the department upon attaining the age of seventeen (17) eighteen (18) years, services may be provided on a case by case basis.
