- 14 of this state or any local ordinance governing motor
- 15 vehicle traffic, may establish or maintain any policy,

2	quota or suggest, formally or informally, a quota for any

7	(i) "Officer" means any peace officer as defined
8	in W.S. $7-2-101(a)(iv)(A)$ and (B); and

10	(ii) "Quota" means any requirement regarding the
11	number of arrests or investigative stops made, or summonses
12	or citations issued, by an officer regarding motor vehicle
13	traffic violations.
