A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to telephone service; amending immunity
2 provisions related to emergency 911 providers; specifying
3 the activities to which immunity applies; and providing for
4 an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 16-9-108 is amended to read:

10 **16-9-108. Immunity for providers.**

12 No basic emergency service provider or service supplier and
13 no employee or agent thereof shall be liable to any person
14 or entity for infringement or invasion of the right of
15 privacy of any person caused or claimed to have been

1 caused, directly or indirectly, by any act or omission in
2 connection with the installation, operation, maintenance,
3 removal, presence, condition, occasion or use of emergency
4 service features, automatic number identification or
5 automatic location identification services and the
6 equipment associated therewith, including the
7 identification of the telephone number, address or name
8 associated with the telephone used by the person accessing
9 911 service, wireless automatic number identification, ~~or~~
10 wireless automatic location identification service or text
11 to 911 service. A governmental entity, public safety
12 agency, local exchange access company, telephone exchange
13 access company or wireless carrier that provides access to
14 an emergency system or any officers, agents or employees
15 thereof is not liable as a result of any act or omission
16 except willful and wanton misconduct or gross negligence in
17 connection with developing, adopting, operating or
18 implementing emergency telephone service, enhanced wireless
19 911 service, text to 911 service or any 911 system.

21 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2015.
